




# Library:

The number of books are now about 10,000 (approx) of which many books are rare and no price can replace them. A good number of Educational and research Journals, Periodicals, Magazines and News papers are readily available for reading. Internet & Xerox facilities are also available in the library. The Annual College Magazine captioned **Bhabikal** is regularly published with the aim to develop students' writing skill and enrich their thinking and inventive mind. Apart from this Wall Magazines namely "Atreyee & Balaka" are also brought out to sharpen the students' writing curiosity, developed their creative mind, fertilize their imagination and strengthen their habit of writing.

Sports & Games: Balurghat B.Ed. College is affiliated to the Dakshin Dinajpur District Sports Association. There is a physical instructor to coach and instruct the players in different games and sports namely Kabbadi, Carom, Volley, Cricket, Table-Tennis, Football etc.



Educational Technology Laboratory (E-T Lab.): The College has a well equipped Smart Class, E-T Lab. with Television facility, DVD, Projector, Slides, Educational Cassettes where the students are used to get teaching in instructional science. Besides, these, A-V aids are also used for conducting seminars, workshops etc.





## Computer Science:

The College has installed a well equipped computer Laboratory consisting of a good number of computers of latest model and technology, feeling the need of imparting sound knowledge of computer to the trainees who will be competent enough to deal with the modern school curriculum in the classroom with Internet facilities.





Co-Curricular Activities : To develop the integrity & interest in the students, the College has introduced various kinds of programmes like drama, recitation, debate, quiz, music, painting, extempore speech. Participation in Adult Education/ Literacy programme, Blood Donation, Publishing articles in College & Wall Magazine, Social Awareness Programmes, Active participation in Nirmal Bangla and Swachh Bharat Abhiyan are compulsorily organized and held as parts of social and national services.







Language Lab :- The College has installed a equipped Language Lab in collaboration with The British Institute, Kolkata to develop students' communicative skill in the English language.

#### Attendance:

Students are to mandatorily ensure 80% attendance of the total number classes held. The students must attend at least 80% of the lectures delivered. Irregularity in attendance may lead to the cancellation of their admission. If they fail to attend 80% of the lectures delivered, they may be treated as non-collegiate and will not be allowed to appear at the Final B.Ed./D.El.Ed. Examination. These rules are strictly followed.

### Working days & College Hours(on all working days except Holidays & Sundays):

There shall be at least 200 working days each year excluding the days of examination and admission, out of which at least 40 days shall be for practice teaching or skill development in nearby govt recognized schools and recognized B.Ed. Colleges for M.Ed. programme. Classes are generally held from 10.15 A.M. to 4.15 P.M. Total weekly working hours are 36 hours.

## Eligibility:

D.EI.Ed. Course: Candidates with at least 50% marks at the Higher Secondary/ Senior Secondary (+2) or its equivalent examination passed with School Subjects are eligible for admission as regular candidates as per NCTE norms.

### **B.Ed. Course:**

Candidates should be Graduates in a school subject from a recognized university.

Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree (General) / or in the Master's Degree in School subjects are eligible to apply.

Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with Science and/or Mathematics, with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are also eligible for admission. Such candidates are required to enter the marks of B.E/B. Tech. in the row of Honours Degree. M.E./M. Tech result (if any) will be entered in the Master's Degree row.

Honours Graduates in school subject should enter the Honours marks only in the row of Bachelor's degree (Honours).

In case of General Graduates, the total marks obtained in general subjects should be entered in the row of Bachelor's degree (General).

For candidates with less than 50% marks in the honours degree, the total marks of pass and Honours subjects will be considered. If it becomes 50% or more, that score will be entered in Graduation (General) row.

For fresh candidates, merit list will be prepared separately for each school subject based on scoring.

For Deputed Candidates, merit list will be prepared separately for each school subject based on length of service.

Relaxation of 5% in the qualifying marks will be allowed in graduation or post graduation in case of SC/ST/PWD.

#### M.Ed. Course:

Eligibility

I. B.Ed Degree of 1 or 2 years duration with 50% marks or equivalent grade (or);

4-year Integrated Teacher Education Programme B.El.Ed /B.A.B.Ed /B.Sc.B.Ed with minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade (or);

D.El.Ed/D.Ed with Bachelors Honours Degree (B.A/ B.Sc/B.Com) each with Minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade II. Graduation with Honours Degree in any subject with 50% marks or B.E/B.Tech Degree with Science and Mathematics with 55% marks

(In the case of Hons. graduates the full marks and marks obtained will be considered only on Hons. papers and not in pass papers)

III. Master's Degree with 50% marks

IV. Relaxation of 5% in the qualifying marks will be allowed in graduation or post graduation in case of SC/ST/PWD.

Admission through Online Application for all courses as per notification of The West Bengal University of Teachers' Training, Education Planning and Administration for B.Ed., M.Ed. courses and West Bengal Board of Primary Education for D.El.Ed. course.

# Migration:

Registration Certificate of WBUTTEPA in case of students who have graduated/post graduated from a University other than the University of WBUTTEPA must be submitted within one Month from the date of admission to this college.
